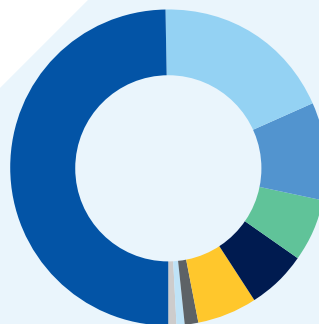

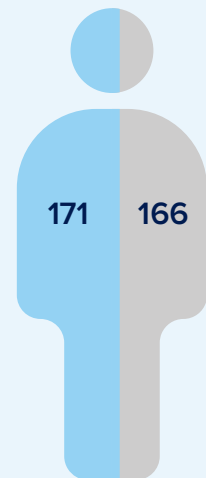

#### RACE AND ETHNICITY



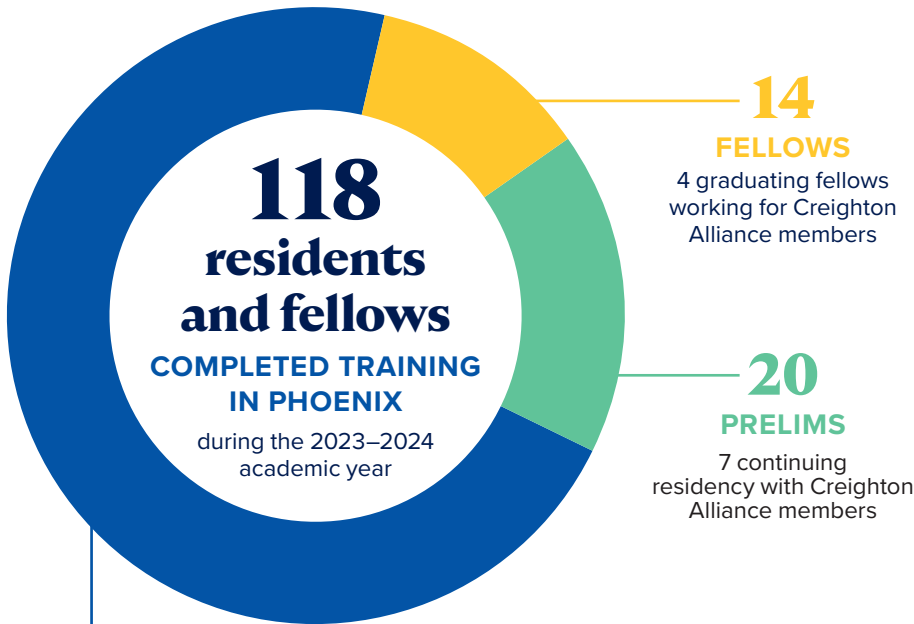

#### GENDER DISTRIBUTION

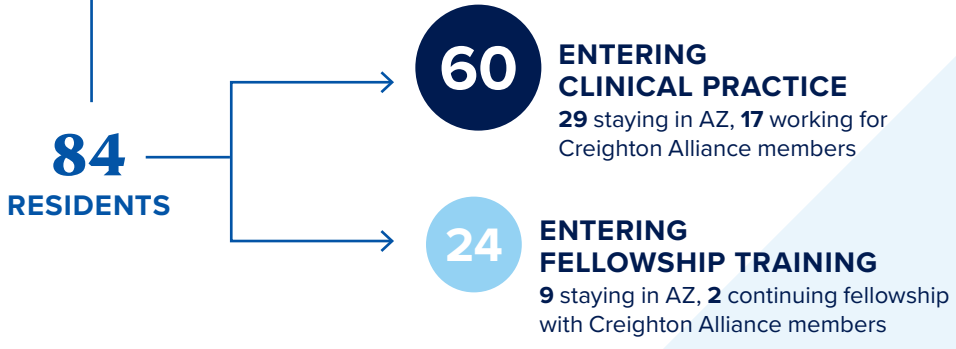
