



Vacancy on the Maricopa County Special Health Care District

Board of Directors

The resignation of Maricopa County Special Health Care District Board Member, Kate Brophy McGee, has left a vacancy on the public board that oversees Arizona's only public teaching hospital and safety net system of care.

"We are grateful for Kate's service and many contributions to our health care system," said Board Chairman Virginia L. Korte. "We wish her well and look forward to working with her in her new role as a member of the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors."

Applicants for appointment to fill Director Brophy McGee's District 3 seat are asked to complete an application and return it with a resume no later than 5:00 p.m., on Thursday, January 16, 2025. The successful applicant will be appointed by the Maricopa County Special Health Care District Board of Directors and will complete the remaining term vacated by Director Brophy McGee. Once appointed, the new District 3 Board Member will serve from the time of appointment until the official canvass of the November 3, 2026, General Election. District 3 serves the cities of Anthem, Cave Creek, Desert Hills, New River, Paradise Valley, and Phoenix. Applicants must:

- Be a qualified elector and reside in District 3.
- Not be an elected or appointed state or county official or a person who serves on a hospital board.
- Not be an employee of the Maricopa County Special Health Care District dba Valleywise Health or a director, officer, or employee of another health care institution.
